

Cultural & Festival Tour for Tourist enter from Phuentsholing (8Days/7 Nights)

Note: An 8-day journey through Bhutan immerses you in its living heritage and vibrant spiritual life across scenic valleys, perfectly timed to experience the magic of a grand Tshechu.

Detailed Itinerary

Day 1: Bagdogra Airport to Phuentsholing

Drive to the Bhutan border and check in at hotel (Phuentsholing). Evening visit to Zangto Pelri Lhakhang and local market.

Day 2: Phuentsholing to Thimphu

Complete immigration permit and drive to Thimphu. Visit Memorial Chorten, Buddha Dordenma and Tashichho Dzong.

Day 3: Thimphu Festival (September)

Witness sacred mask dances (Cham) and vibrant spiritual traditions at Thimphu Tshechu in Tashichho Dzong, where wearing traditional Gho or Kira is highly recommended.

Day 4: Thimphu to Punakha

Drive to Punakha via the scenic Dochula Pass. Visit Chimi Lhakhang (Fertility Temple) and Punakha Dzong. Overnight in Punakha.

Day 5: Punakha-Wangdue -Phobjikha Valley

Continue drive to Phobjikha Valley via Wangdue, visiting Gangtey Monastery and enjoying a nature walk with optional farmhouse stay.

Day 6: Phobjikha Valley to Paro

Return to Paro. Visit National Museum and Rinpung Dzong. Explore Paro town market. Overnight at Paro.

Day 7: Hike to Taktsang (Tiger's Nest Monastery)

Early hike to Paro Taktsang for pilgrimage, followed by optional hot stone bath and evening market visit.

Day 8: Departure

Drive back to Bagdogra Airport for departure.

Details of Itinerary

8 Days / 7 Nights | A Celebration of Living Heritage

Experience the soul of Bhutan through its most vibrant festivals, sacred monasteries, and timeless valleys where spirituality, culture, and daily life blend seamlessly. Timed with the grand Thimphu Tshechu, this journey offers rare access to Bhutan's living traditions.

Day 1 Arrival in Bagdogra Airport- Transfer to Phuntsholing

Upon arrival meet and greet at Bagdogra Airport then a scenic drive through the lush tea gardens of West Bengal toward the Bhutanese border town, Phuntsholing.

Visit the Zangto Pelri Lhakhang, a central temple representing the celestial abode of Guru Rinpoche. Explore the vibrant local market for your first taste of Bhutanese street food and halt at Phuntsholing.

Day 2 Phuntsholing to Thimphu

Complete the immigration formalities and start breathtaking climb from the subtropical plains to the cool, alpine air of Thimphu (2,334m).

Visit to Buddha Dordenma one of the world's largest sitting Buddha statues, Memorial Chorten and Tashichho Dzong for the "Fortress of the Glorious Religion," which houses the throne room and government offices.

Day 3 Thimphu Tshechu – Festival Immersion

Step into Bhutan's spiritual heart at the Thimphu Tshechu held at Tashichho Dzong, where monks and performers in elaborate silk costumes present sacred Cham dances depicting Buddhist teachings an unforgettable cultural spectacle; wearing traditional Gho or Kira is encouraged for a deeper local connection.

Day 4 Thimphu – Punakha (The Golden Valley)

Journey to Punakha via the breathtaking Dochula Pass, adorned with 108 chortens, then visit the revered Chimi Lhakhang before exploring the majestic Punakha Dzong set at the confluence of two rivers.

Day 5 Punakha – Phobjikha Valley

Travel through Wangdue into the tranquil Phobjikha Valley, a pristine glacial valley, where you will visit the serene Gangtey Monastery and enjoy a peaceful nature walk; optional farmhouse stay offers an authentic glimpse into Bhutanese rural life.

Day 6 Phobjikha – Paro

Return to Paro and delve into Bhutan's rich heritage with visits to the Ta Dzong and the impressive Rinpung Dzong, followed by leisure time in the town's local markets.

Day 7 the Tiger's Nest Pilgrimage

Embark on a memorable hike to Paro Taktsang, Bhutan's most iconic and sacred site perched dramatically on a Cliffside, begin early for a serene experience, and conclude your day with an optional traditional Bhutanese hot stone bath.

Day 8 | Departure

Early morning departure from Paro to Bagdogra via Phuntsholing.
